### KK launches Relief Camp for Flood affected in Peshawar, Karak and D.I Khan



Due to the recent flood catastrophe, our Province Khyber Puktoonkhwā has been badly affected. This catastrophe left families homeless in a greater magnitude. KK took prompt initiative and engaged volunteers for the donation collection and in distribution of food items and non food items. KK staff voluntarily went to open markets, homes, factories and Karkhano market to collect money, clothes, shoes and medicines. The collected items were further distributed among the affected families in Charsadda and Nowshera..

### Khwendokor team distributed food items among flood affected People



Khwendokor's committed team distributed the food items, clothing to the flood affected who were waiting for the relief and support from people. The flood affected women were also provided with hygiene kits by keeping in view their immediate need.

### Five Skillful Women groups identified at Jamrud

KK has identified a group of five women in FATA Jamrud for beads work. As skilled human resource these women will prepare beads products. The community women are highly skilled in beads work and their skill will provide better income generation to them by doing work at their homes.

## Free Medical Camps in Dir Upper:

In continues efforts of KK for flood affects people our Upper Dir team purchased medicines for arranging six medical camps at six flood affected villages of Gor Kohi, Batal, Nasnamal, Samkot, Usheri Khas and Galkor. During the six medical camps, more then 1200 patients were given free medical services.



The Health Department and PPHI contributed in providing Doctors and Paramedics staff to KK for these medical camps. The Medical Camps were conducted especially for women and children. The main diseases treated during the free Medical Camps were skin, pain, headache, stomach, eye diseases and diarrhea.

## Paint Work at Schools, Basic Health Unit, in progress Dir Upper :

Paint work and color scheming for the schools and health facilities is being done in Dir Upper under the project of PPAF. In order to bring better color scheming, Graphic Designer from head office supported and guided the team.



Regional Manager Mr.Ibrash Pasha also visits the schools and health facilities to monitor the work. The team also collects data of widows and affected women case studies for the KK regional office Dir for DIL and UNDP projects.

## DCO's NOC for KK Mansehra Regional office

Mansehra Region got NOC (No Objection Certificate) from DCO Mansehra through DDMA In which the District Government of Mansehra gave permission to KK for doing its Humanitarian and Development Activities in the District and also ensured its coordination with other line Departments for the smooth running of KK Programmes with in the district.

## Training on Gender sensitization and RBA

Six Gender sensitization and project specific trainings arranged for community groups 3 for male and 3 for female community groups in 3 villages of District Mansehra. External consultants were engaged in trainings, in which 310 female and 242 male community



members participated. They were make able to differentiate between gender and sex. They were sensitized regarding women rights especially women right of inheritance and consent in their marriages.

## Cluster Discussion among Community groups

Regional Office M a n s e h r a arranged 40 c l u s t e r discussions in 20 villages of 5 Union Council's. Out of 40 c l u s t e r discussions, 20 were arranged for female with 298 female participants and the rest for male with 274 participants. The cluster discussions were held to ensure and support the right based activities at village level and link GBV survivors with service providers through CFCs. (Community Facilitation Center)

## Meetings with Stakeholders- Mansehra

Five Coordination meetings with District Stakeholders i.e Social Welfare Officer, DCO, Manager Radio Buraq, DDMA and JUI Ameer Mansehra Molana Hadiat Ullah Shah were arranged by Mansehra region. The purpose of these meetings were technical, legal and religious support for smooth running of KK's NCA project's activities.

## KK and Social Welfare Department - MOU

In the light of NOC, KK Mansehra Region signed MOU with Social Welfare Department in the month of August for good coordination, sustainability of NCA project, Linkages development and technical Support.

## Meetings for Community Groups in Mansehra region

CFC Facilitators of RO Mansehra arranged five monthly coordination meetings at CFC level, among community groups. The purpose of the meeting was to raise awareness on "Women rights to inheritance and consent in marriages" among the community members of Mansehra region.

## **KK displays Mazari Product at WBDC**

A display centre has been allotted to Khwendo Kor through SMEDA in Women Business Development Center working under Social Welfare Department. WBDC works as a centre for sales and linkages.

Khwendo Kor's Mazari products have been displayed in the centre and a nominal fee of Rs. 50/ week is paid. The display centre has become the point for the sale of beautiful work of community women. So far more than Rs. 2000/- sale has been made during the month of August. WBDC has further placed the Mazari products on Avon Super Store and requested for demand of more mazari products with better innovation.



## **14th August in RO Karak**

KK RO Karak celebrate "Independence Day" in three CBGPS of three villages namely Kanda Baji Khel, Chatta Banda and Walaki Muhabbat Khel in which 171 students and 38 VEC, WOs and MOs members participate in 14th August Independence Day. In all CBGPS the students presented Naat Sharif, National songs, Quiz competition and general information and skits.
