## Encouraging Community Led Social Services

### Education, Peshawar

February 25th, 2011 RPU Peshawar established center in village Tehsil Jamrud with the support of local community right now 25 Learners are coming regularly and getting benefit from the available resources Meeting conducted with women regarding importance of education in our society especially in FATA. The women appreciated Khwendu Kor work and demanded upon education as well as skill. The community, especially women felt very happy about opening such a center. Women are more interested in skills training than literacy.

March 16, 2011 CF education conducted training to village education Committee. The total beneficiaries of training were 18. Community Facilitator also conducted session regarding education.



### Education Sector, Dir Upper

In education Project the paints work completed in Government Primary School (GPS) Dislawar and Government Girls Primary School (GGPS). Gandigar Masson, carpenter and electrification work completed in GPS Chukyatan and GGHS Kotkey.

### Washing Places, Dir Upper

Washing places were installed in GGHS Kotkey, GPS Chukyatan, GPS Shahi Bagh, GGPS Daskor, GPS Nashnamal, GPS Almas and GGPS Galkor, GGPS Landai Shah and GGPS Dislawar

## Sports Equipments, Dir Upper

Sports equipments were installed at GGPS Shahi Bagh, GGPS Dislawar, GGPS Sundal ,GHS jatgram and GPS Chukyatan, and GPS Wari no 2.



## Library Establishment, Dir Upper

Libraries established in 24 schools and provided 2000 books to each school for library to improve the quality of education. Teachers and parents were sensitized to specify separate period for library in the school time table.

Some of the community members told that it is the first time in the history of Dir Upper that libraries established in Primary school and appreciated the efforts of Khwendo Kor for education and health.



## Students Chairs, Dir Upper

Students chairs were provided to GPS Darora, GPS Wari No2, GPS Shakanai, GGPS Shinkarai, GGPS Shahi Bagh. The parents teachers council representative were present on the occasion and appreciated the Khwendo Kor for quality education.

## PTC Meeting at Shegai Girls' School, Dir Lower

This school is situated in mountainous area of Dir lower. People have no awareness about the importance of females' education and it is the reason that the literacy ratio is very low in that area. So the KK team visited there and conducted meeting with the students' parents and teacher on the importance of females' education. The parents told that now they have realized how important it is to send their children to school and the participants also appreciated the KK efforts for females' education.

## TBA's Training, Dir Upper

In village Nasser Abad 30 days training for TBA's with 25 participants was conducted. The training was facilitated by KK LHV Ms.Farida.

## TBA' Kits Distribution, Dir Upper

Khwendo Kor Dir Upper, distributed TBA's Kits in 97 TBA's under SM project Health supported by PPAF in different clusters of Dir Upper. In Naseer abad cluster there are 25 TBA's in Wari cluster 22 ,in Sundal cluster 18, in Shinkari Akhagram cluster 16, in Usheri cluster 16TBAs. The TBA's were very happy on occasion and they promised they will use the training for the benefit of the community.



## Free Medical Camps, Dir Upper

Free medical camps were conducted for women and children at village Kakad, (204 patient) Moha Dab (with 268 patient), BHU Pataw (with 285 patients) , Usherai (with 252 patients), Daskor bala (with 255 paints), GGPS Shinkara (180 patients), GGPS Islamabad 205 and Daskor Payeen 190 patients.

Khwendo Kor doctor checked the patients and provide medicine free of cost to the patients.



## Free Medical Camp at Village Misyalorh, Dir Lower

Before arranging the medical camp the Social Organizers visited to the village Misyalor. This is situated on Dir Lower and Swat border and it's a mountainous area located on hilltop. It's a far-flung village and can be reached after one and half hour drive from KK Timergara office. There are no facilities of hospitals, clinics and dispensaries in the area. The peoples are very poor due to which their access is not possible to the hospitals, which are far away from them. This area is also one of the effected villages from the 2010 Monsoon rains as well as affected from militancy.



The KK field team identified some common diseases, from which peoples were suffering. These diseases are, skin diseases, fever, respiratory tract infection, diarrhea, and many minor diseases. KK decided to arrange a free medical camp in this area upon the demand of community peoples.

Process:

The KK team jointly with the community selected a centrally located place in the village for arranging the medical camp. The KK team was consisting of qualified medical Doctor, pharmacist, LHV, and other support staff. The medical camp start from 10 AM till 5PM on 4th Feb, 2011. The Doctor prescribed medicines to the patients and pharmacist and LHV provided medicines to them. The patient record was maintained by the Male Social organizers.

During the medical camp Doctor examined 186 patients and provided medical care. Majority of them were suffering from skin diseases, fever, cough, diarrhea, and body pain. The majority of the patients were children and women. These patients include 59 women, 49 girls, 25 men and 40 boys.

Issues during the medical camp.

During the medical camp the doctor identified that some of the patients are chronically ill and suffering from hepatitis, diabetes and they were not treatable in the medical camp. The Doctor gave them advice and guideline and referred them to the district head quarter hospital for detailed examination and treatment.

Similarly many patients remained untreated in the medical camp due to shortages of the medicines. The medicines were not enough to treat all patients.

The community peoples appreciated KK for arranging medical camp and providing such type of facility to them at village. They also demanded to arrange such camps every month.



## Good Governance

### Celebrated International Women Day at Nishtar Hall Peshawar

This year International Women day completed 100 years of celebration. Civil society organizations take initiative to celebrate international women day at Provincial level in KP. This was held on 8th March at Nishtar Hall Peshawar. International Women's Day was about equal access to education, training, science and technology for the women. Purpose of this activity was awareness raising, highlight the economic, political and social achievements of women. More then 250 participants participated from civil society and every walk of life. The leading organization was Khwendo Kor, Net, AWARD, AF, ABKT and Shirkat Gha. KK Chief Executive Maryam Bibi was also present on the occasion.



### Aman Itihad Convention, Peshawar

Khwendo Kor is the focal organization at KP level for Aman Itihad activities, Aman Ithad Provincial Convention was held on Tuesday, March 22nd 2011 at Archives Hall and Library Peshawar. Ms. Rashda takes the lead role in the event and awarded the people on Aman Ithad role and brings their suggestions on convention in shape of Imrani Muahida. Alliance partners actively participated and invited the participants from their communities like community based organizations, lawyers, Media and every walk of life people. In this activity more than 300 participants were participated from civil society including male and female.



### NOC Extension, Mansehra

In the month of Feb 2011 NOC extension letter was issued by DDMA for activities continuity. After a successfully NCA project implementation Social Welfare Department assessed NCA project and share a detail impact assessment report on implantation strategies and impact. On the bases of that report DCO and DDMA extend KK Mansehra region NOC for further one year till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011.

### MIS Training at NRSP Islamabad

In the month of February Micro Enterprise staff attended one day training on MIS. The following outcome obtained from training.

### **Outcome of the Training, Mansehra**

Develop the core information systems management skills and competencies. The core competencies include MIS / IT knowledge, planning, control, problem-solving and communication. The participant will be able to use MIS Software.

### **Meeting with Khushali Bank, Mansehra**

Coordination meeting arranged with Khushali bank for to link credit group with Khushali bank and collection of information regarding micro credit for KK working area Community groups.

### **Meeting with DRU Regarding Harassment Act , Mansehra**

The stakeholders meeting conducted at DRU Mansehra arranged by ERRA Gender Unit Mansehra. KK Mansehra Region participated in it and the objective of the meeting was;

- Consultation on Harassment Act 509
- Develop action plan for implementation strategies
- Capacity building of stakeholders on Harassment Act

All the participants oriented on Harassment act and Harassment committee formation process was also discussed.

### **Annual Meeting with NCA and Norway Ambassador, Mansehra**

The meeting conducted at Best Western Hotel Islamabad arranged by NCA. Before sharing achievements with Norway Embassy representative, NCA met with KK official and reviewed previous year achievements and shortcomings. NCA appreciated KK work and suggested that IEC material should be share before printing.

After the review of partner organization KK presented their achievements to Norway Embassy representative and they appreciated NCA and its partners on their efforts in bringing gender justice in community. Norway Embassy promised for future support to NCA and its partners.

### **Attended 03 days Sensitization of partners Organization on peace and conflict Resolution, Mansehra**

KK Mansehra region staff attended three days training on "Sensitization of partners Organization on peace and conflict Resolution". The participants learnt about the history and causes of conflict, role of civil society, Role of media, Role of women in conflict reduction and peace building. The purpose of the training was Participants will be able to play their role in peace building and conflict reduction



### **Resolved Gender Based Violence survivor's cases, Mansehra**

In the month Feb and March 8 cases resolved in the favor of survivors with the involvement and support of KK Mansehra Region. All cases were family matters.

### **Monthly Coordination Meetings, Mansehra**

The following Coordination meetings with stake holders were conducted for UN women project orientation and Amman committee formation at District level. All the stake holders appreciated KK efforts, and its contribution in peace bringing and gender justice

Meetings with EDO Population, President Press club, President Press club Mansehra, MPA Sajida Tabassam, influential peoples of District Mansehra, ex District members of local bodies, community activist of Union Council, Battal, Lchrian, Malik Pur and Bheer Kund. Of District Mansehra , CRG Members of FAFAN District Mansehra, SAIBAAN Organization, Aurat Association District Mansehra, Social Welfare Officer District Mansehra, Musahaliati Anjuman Committee members District Mansehra regarding Orientation on UN Women project for peace committee formation.

## **Sustainable Livelihoods**

### **Provision of Forest Plants for Plantation in Different villages of Chontra valley 2011, Karak**

As sites were selected for the spring plantation 2011 in the previous month. So in this month the planned numbers of plants at planned sites were ensured to be planted and we have provided the plants to selected farmers in chontra valley 2011. The details of the plantation are 600 Keekar at Walaki village, 2000 Keekar & Sheesham at Essak Ghundi Kalla, 500 Keekar at Biland Kalla, 500 Keekar & 200 Sheesham at Sarat Khel, 500 Keekar & Sheesham at Mishki Khel and 500 Poplar at Noor Sanam pond village Tabi Khwa. We have facilitated the LP in plantation at Kanda Baji khel in water shed made by soil conservation department Karak. LFFS had been started and developed the Grant proposal for LFFS (Male & Female) through Livestock consultants.

## Arranged Livestock Training, Established ALC, Karak

Other we have identified the farmers for Ground nut demo plots and we have provided ten demo plots of Ground nut to the farmers in Chontra valley. In this year we have provided the Bari variety. One orchard established at Kand Baji khel for one farmer in LP project. . We have arranged the Livestock management training at Office. In this training 24 farmers participation from different villages namely Tabi Khwa, Biland Kalla, Zebi kalla, Doda Khel, Metha khel, Talab Khel, Chani Khel, Walaki Mohabat Khel, Tarkha Koi and Dab kalla of Chontra valley. We have established 03 ALCs in two villages namely Metha Khel(Sangatri and Taki Metha Khel) and Tabi Khwa. The total enrollments in three ALCs are 90. The ALCs will start work from 1st April 2011. Facilitation in 05 days training to ALCs teachers at Agriculture office Karak. We have also provided the ALC booklets and other necessary ALC supplies.

IC Delegate came on a special visit to Karak. There IC Delegate visited to Tabi Khwa and Mashki Khel villages for seeing the water ponds which are recently constructed. he also visited Walaki Mohabat Khel village there IC Delegate monitored the LFFS female and Walaki community based primary school which will be hand over to NEF. IC delegate appreciated the hard work of Khwendo Kor regarding Education and social organization and mobilization. At the end VO presented their presentation. In this presentation VO presided the intervention of KK and LP. After Walaki visit the Delegate visited Metha Khel village where we have established wheat improved variety seeds plots. All the farmers were waiting for the guest and community members warmly welcomed them. In Metha Khel Delegate monitored the wheat plots and met the farmers. After this Delegate attend the meeting with Ground nut Association. After this Delegate visited Kanda Baji khel there one water shed constructed by soil conservation department. The soil conservation officer briefed the Delegate. After this the Delegate came to our Regional Office KK Karak and attends meting with KK staff. RM briefed the Delegate about KK Programme and Regions and other problems /challenges which are faced Khwendo Kor. The IC delegate's feedback was good and they appreciated KK for the working in remote Areas of KP.

Another RO Karak arranged the celebration of Pakistan Day (23rd March) at CBGPS at Kanda Baji Khel and CBGPS Chatha Banda. All the students celebrated 23rd March and sung the National songs and did speeches.

## Relief and Rehabilitation

### Painting in Government Girls Model School GORE, Dir Lower

Government girls' middle school Gore is situated in Maidan area of District Dir Lower. It was the center of militants (Taliban). It was the aims and objectives of militants (Taliban) to destroy and burn the girl's school in particular and boys schools in general.

The militants collected all the furniture of the school in the rooms and burnt it. Due to which four rooms totally and the whole building partially were become black, due to which it was impossible to continue education activities in such school. For students attractive and healthy environment is very important to continue their education. So KK feel the need of painting the school and the school was painted in a good way and now the school is looking very shiny and attractive in the whole area and have a positive impact on the students.



### Painting in Dalgram School, Dir Lower

Government girls' middle school Dalgram is situated in the hilly area of Dir lower. The area is backward therefore people have no proper awareness about education particularly female education. And that school was in a very bad condition. The over all condition of the school was very bad like there were holes in the walls. The white wash was looking very ugly and a lot of repair was required in doors and windows.

KK feel the need of that works in the school and complete it in the best way. Now the school is looking very beautiful and shiny.



### Repairing of Boundary Wall and Toilet, Dir Lower

The Dalgram girl school was looking as a general play ground for the villagers because from the three side the boundary wall was fallen due to which people and animals were easily entered into school after working hours, after repairing the wall now it is very safe and secure from any entries and the KK also repair the bathroom which was the basic need of students and teachers.

### Installing of Water Hand Pump in Girls High School Lalqila, Dir Lower

In the Girls High school Lal Qila, there was no water supply source but available a well of water but it was uncovered from the top which was risky and there was no source of pumping water, so KK installed the water hand pump due to which it become safe and secure from any tragedy and also become a source of providing water any time.
