Education Sector, Dir Lower:

● Most of the community based girls schools, which were running in single room because of small spaces, the students were sitting outside from the room & exposed to hot sun. KK team felt the dire need to improve the infrastructure of the schools. So shelters were constructed with CGI sheets & wood are provided by KK. Now students are safe from hot sun.

Activities at Schools, Dir Lower:

● During the month different events were organized by different schools. i.e. Wara banda, Kala Dehry, Alam abad and Shawa Kohi, regarding sports competition, drawing competition, science quiz, naat khwani, songs, roleplay skits & cleanliness events. Students, teachers as well as parents participated in these events. At the end, prizes were distributed among position holder (students), participated in the programme.

Education Sector, Dir Upper

- Paint at GGHS Kotkey was completed.
- Electric fans were installed at GGPS Islamabad, GPS Wari No.02. GMS Naseerabad, GGPS Landai Shah, GPS Darora, GGPS Gandigar, GPS Chukyatan, GGPS Sundal Shagai and GPS Dislawar.
- Stationary was provided to GHS Jatgram.
- Meeting with PTCs at different schools were held in which different matters related to education were discussed.
- Sports items were provided to GGHS Samkot & GHS Jatgram.
- Meeting with EDO education was held during the UN working group meeting in which matters related to education & KK work with education deptt was shared.
- Plants were distributed in KK's selected education faculties. Paints of plantation beds were painted in all these elected schools.

Education Sector Karak

- Meeting was held regarding Expansion of Pakistan Coalition of Education activities with KK working districts in Karak. The main theme of this expansion is to increase female education and bring reforms in national policy. 19 Participants attended the meeting on June 23, 2011 in Dawn polytechnic institution Amberi Kalla karak.
- Karak team has facilitated meeting of communities and different political leaders on the constitution of the political parties in the target districts and province.

● The issue of non-availability of the Science teacher in Govt. Girls high school at Badwan was solved by KK as the school principal was not giving admission to the student in Metric science. KK team facilitated the community & student for writing an application to the Executive District Officer & that application was forwarded by KK team. The education Deptt. coordinated with the school principal. As a result now the girls are getting admission in Metric science in the same school.

Advocacy , Dir Upper

Community Dispensary (CD) is shifted to new building with the coordination among community & EDO health by KK team. This is a big achievement of KK.

Following things are handed over to CD staff.

- Medical Equipments.
- Medicines.
- Cheques are also distributed among the flood affected families from US Herai Dara, Karo Dara & Moha Sharif.

Good Governance Karak

- Karak Team upraised awareness and sensitization among communities and policy makers on the identified gaps in Health and Education sector through on-air FM radio.
- Meeting was arranged in village Shuggi Lawaghar on June 27, 2011 with Madarsa Authority and community, in which Madarsa policies were discussed.



Advocacy , Karak

- Karak team has enhanced Advocacy and lobbying skills of KK partner organization in kando khel organization on June 03, 2011. 15 participants were attended the training. It was discussed that the present government monitoring system is nominal and there are so many hospitals and schools which has no staff and other required facilities. Most of the staff is found absent from their duty stations which cause of loss in the development process.
- Exposure visit was done from Madrassa Hafsa lil-bant Babal khel Karak to Madrassa Aysha saddiqa lil- on June 27, 2011. In which 9 women the participated for learning and experience sharing. The Madrassa of kohat is working from 12 years while the Madrassa of the Karak is from 2 years.

- Following issue were identified on June, 6, 2011 at village Chokara to the members of WOs, on which KK will definitely work.
- ✓ Low interest of teachers.
- ✓ Untrained teacher hiring.
- ✓ No basic facilities in the schools.
- ✓ Low access
- ✓ PTAs based only on papers.
- ✓ No monitoring of the education department.
- ✓ Hiring of none local teachers.
- ✓ Parents do not give attention on their child.
- ✓ High fee of the private doctors.
- ✓ High rates of medicines.
- ✓ During accidents ambulance facilities are not available.
- ✓ NO first Aid centers
- ✓ No monitoring of the health
- ✓ Lack of hospitals.
- ✓ No basic facilities in the hospitals.
- ✓ Lack of girls Schools.
- ✓ Doctors do not pay attention towards Patients in Govt. hospitals.

6th speech competitions organized in the month of June, 03 for female and 03 for Male Students. The competition was arranged among Govt. and private schools students. There were 175 girls and 141 boys participated in competition.

The purpose of the competition was "To enhance the student's skills and awareness arising among Youth, about Women Right Inheritance and Consent in Marriage".

Achievement(Kacc Registration), Bannu

KK Bannu team successfully registered Khwendo Kor Area Coordination Committee (KACC), named as District Advisory Board for Sustainable Development (DABSD) with Social Welfare Department. The name is changed due to the decision made during KK Board of Directors meeting. DABSD is now formally registered under 1961 ordinance (XLVI of 1961) under the registration number 3563.

Its Executive body consists of 09 members including 01 female member.

Activity (2 Days Cleanness Campaign) Bannu

KK Bannu Region organized two days cleanness campaign in Bannu City. A meeting was arranged in order to raise awareness regarding cleanness in the city. The meeting was conducted in the Tehsil Municipal Committee Hall Bannu.

The D.C.O. Bannu (Dr. Imran Hamid Sheikh) and T.M.O. Bannu (Mr. Raouf Ullah), & Regional Manager Khwendo Kor Asmat Kamal Mahsud participated in the meeting.

FAFEN Project Constituency Staff Training, at D.I Khan

FA FEN Project Staff Training was held at D.I.Khan on 14-15th June,2011, regarding introduction of Supporting Transparency,Accountability & Electoral process in Pakistan (STAEP).

KK FA FEN staff from D.I.Khan,Tank,North & South Waziristan were participated in training.

Cash Distribution, Karak

Karak region disbursed Rs, 145000/- for 7 skillful women in 2 villages to support their family for income generating through small businesses in their home.

Training on Proposal Writing, Peshawar

Activity In Uc Mathra & Alizai, Peshawar

● The area UC Mathra, which is backward & flood affected but agricultural area of Dist. Peshawar, visited by Khwendokor Peshawar region on June 3rd, 2011. That agricultural area was destroyed by flood, so MO & farmer Group were formed, their roles & responsibilities were assigned & discussed on behalf of FOSI project. The main theme of this activity was to rebuild their farms & agricultural system.

● Visit was also done on 15th June, 2011 by Peshawar Region team to the village Alizai for the purpose of the meeting with MO. The agenda of that meeting was "The formation of DMC (Disaster Management Committee) & EPC (Environmental Management Committee).

● CNIC's have been handed over to almost more than 1000 women by KK MO & CRG members through NADRA at their door steps.

These women had been registered their CNIC's with NADRA in "CNIC's Registration Camp" which was held on April 4, 2011 in four major tribes (Ashokhel, Hassan Khel, Jankor & Jawakai) of FR Peshawar & one day in Jamrud Khyber.



Cheques issuance to the Flood Affected People , Peshawar

On June 8th, 2011 two Cheques of amount of Rs. 30,400 to each were issued to the flood affected people of the Mohmand Agency for the reconstruction of their houses after confirming through survey by the KK Staff and MCED Organization (KK partner Organization).
